Action Taken Report

In compliance to directives issued by EE Division of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India vide letter F.No. 8-6/2019-EE dated 24.11.2020 in regard to celebration of Constitution Day on 26th day of November 2020 by all State Nodal Agencies implementing Eco-Club Programme, the SNA Sikkim, that is, Sikkim ENVIS Hub, Forest and Environment Department facilitated the celebration of Constitution Day on November 26, 2020 in coordination with 856 eco-clubs at schools and colleges across the State.

The Preamble to the Constitution of India was read out at forest secretariat premise administered at 11 am by CCF Shri D. C Nepal also participated by Chairman SPCB Sikkim Dr. Thomas Chandy and senior officers and staff of the department. Pledge certificate was handed over to the participants as well (**sample copy attached in Annexure I**). Similar event was conducted at district forest offices, schools and colleges to promote constitutional values among citizens (**letter attached in Annexure II**).

Clean up drives of respective office and institutional premises were conducted by officers and staff, teachers and students. Taxi Driver Associations of major towns such as Jorethang, Geyzing, Mangan and Gangtok also conducted clean up drive and sensitization drive at the respective premises. Waste bins, gloves, face masks, hand sanitizers were distributed to safai karmacharis. The programme was conducted as a part of Swachhata Action Plan 2020-21 funded by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India.

Sikkim SNA received more than 1000 photos through WhatsApp groups of Eco-Club Network and few videos as well. The Eco-Clubs also conducted clean up drives, lectures, seminars, essay wriring, power point presentation, virtual meets etc to mark the event. **About 70+ such photos have been uploaded in SNA's facebook page**
